Forklift Operator Training BC - In North America, lift truck operator training is required in order to prevent workplace accidents and injuries. Training sessions are tailored for various working environments, such as outdoors on a construction site or enclosed stores. Course content includes everyday inspection procedures and safety protocol. Trainees learn the way to maneuver in a populated work setting.

When operated by an inexperienced person, a lift truck can be very dangerous. In order to reduce the risk of accident, potential operators have to undertake forklift training by a qualified instructor prior to operating a forklift. All aspects of forklift utilization are included in training programs. The abilities and limitations of the equipment are covered, together with fundamental operating measures, pre-operation checks and methods of warning other staff that a forklift is in the work site.

Lessons consist of the placement of the chock blocks and trailer tires, the arrangement of pallets to distribute the load right, and checks required before driving into a trailer at a dock site. Courses also consist of Material Safety Data Sheet (or MSDS) training. Although not related directly to the operation of a forklift, MSDS training is important if an operator notices a leaking container or damages a container containing toxic materials. MSDS sheets list the proper ways of handling spills, the products and their effects on people.
