Each of these questions must be answered with "yes" if all the safety regulations and rules are being followed. A "no" to any question indicates a procedural flaw that can cause injury, damage to machine or accident.

- 1) Is the traffic of the pedestrians separate from the operating are of the forklift?
- 2) Is pedestrian access to forklift travel areas restricted by barriers?
- 3) The pedestrian walkways well-marked?
- 4) A sign is clearly visible stating a "lift truck in operation"?
- 5) Are mirrors for drivers and pedestrians provided at blind spots?
- 6) Are alterations to daily forklift schedules communicated to all affected employees?
- 7) The lift truck tires being utilized are suitable for all operating surfaces?
- 8) Forklift seatbelt is being used?
- 9) Is the seat in good condition?
- 10) The maintenance schedule of the forklift is being followed?
- 11) Is a yearly forklift certification and inspection carried out?
- 12) Is the forklift right for the needed tasks?
- 13) Does forklift has a readable load chart?
- 14) Do all operators understand how to read the load chart?
- 15) The chart lists the safe lifting capacity for all attachments and their uses?
- 16) Are the warning devices on the forklift working correctly?
- 17) The speed operating control device is secured right?
- 18) The lift truck overhead cage is fitted right?
- 19) Do the operators of the forklift have certifications to operate the machine?
- 20) Speed limits and warning signs are being observed?
- 21) The operators have current training for the lift trucks being utilized?
- 22) Do operators know their responsibilities to report any equipment damage and lift truck accidents?
- 23) Prior to the equipment being used, the pre-test checklist is being reviewed each day?
